



Recommendations for Selecting SafeCare Staff In Your Agency

- Home Visitors
 - Individuals who are comfortable delivering interventions to families in the home setting
 - Individuals who are open to learning and implementing new curricula or intervention programs
 - Individuals who are open to delivering a highly structured intervention
 - Individuals who are able to deliver new material
 - Individuals who are able to be both creative and flexible in delivering services to families
 - Individuals who are open and responsive to supervision and feedback
 - Minimum education requirements: Bachelor's level degree in the following areas (Social Work, Social Sciences, Early Childhood Education, or Psychology)

- Coaches
 - Individuals with good communication and interpersonal skills
 - Individuals with experience implementing new approaches, programs, or systems for working with the families may be helpful
 - Responsibilities may include:
 - Conducting weekly individual supervision, including supporting home visitors during one-on-one sessions
 - Leading weekly team meetings
 - Listening to audio tapes and accompanying home visitors into the field in order to assess SafeCare fidelity
 - Organizing and managing certification scores and accompanying documents
 - Minimum education requirements: Bachelor's level degree in the following areas (Social Work, Social Sciences, Early Childhood Education, or Psychology)
